1. Sri Chandra Prakash Singh Rajput, has filed vakalatnama on behalf of respondent no. 4 today in the Court which is taken on record.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners, learned A.G.A. for the State, Sri Chandra Prakash Singh Rajput, learned counsel for the respondent no. 4 and perused the record.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are wholly innocent and have been falsely implicated in the instant case due to ulterior motive. He has next submitted that the victim/ respondent no.4 is a major lady and has been in consensual physical relationship with the petitioner no.1 for the last 5 years. However, subsequently, when he had refused to marry her, the impugned F.I.R. has maliciously been lodged against the petitioners just with an intention to harass and humiliate them and drag them in criminal court though no offence whatsoever is disclosed against the petitioners and as such, the impugned F.I.R. is liable to be quashed.
4. Matter requires consideration.
5. Learned counsel for the respondent no. 4 prays for and is granted four weeks time to file counter affidavit.
6. Learned A.G.A. may also file counter affidavit within the same period. Rejoinder affidavit, if any, may be filed within a week thereafter.

7. List this case on 07.04.2026.

8. Till then, the petitioners shall not be arrested in pursuance of impugned F.I.R. dated 25.12.2025 registered as Case Crime No. 522 of 2025 u/s 69, 351(3) B.N.S. and 3(2)(V) S.C./S.T. Act, Police Station- Nawabad, District- Jhansi.
