1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant, learned counsel for opposite party no.2 as well as learned AGA for the State and perused the records.

2. The present application U/S 528 BNSS has been filed by the applicant with the prayer to quash the charge-sheet dated 20.09.2012, cognizance/ summoning order dated 16.01.2013, non bailable warrant order dated 09.01.2026 as well as entire proceedings of Criminal Case No.42/13 (State Vs. Anwar Ahmad), arising out of Case Crime No.1016 of 2012, under Sections 498A, 323, 506 I.P.C. and 3/4 D.P. Act, Police Station Kotwali, District Rampur, pending in the Court of First Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rampur on the basis of compromise deed dated 08.12.2025.

3. Learned counsels for both the parties jointly submit that the parties have reconciled their differences and a compromise has been entered between them out of court. In this regard, a compromise deed has been filed stating therein that they have amicably settled their dispute and the prosecutrix does not want to proceed with the case further, copy of said affidavits have been annexed as Annexure no.5 to this application.

4. Learned AGA for the State submits that the compromise effected between the parties may be verified before the court

concerned.

5. In the interest of justice, the applicant and the opposite party no. 2 are directed to appear before the court concerned along with a certified copy of this order as well as copy of the compromise deed within four weeks from today, which shall be verified by the court concerned and a report in this regard shall be submitted before this Court within two weeks thereafter. While passing the order verifying the compromise, the concerned court shall also record the statement of the parties as to whether all the terms and conditions mentioned in the original compromise deed, so filed, have been fulfilled or not?

6. List this case on 07.04.2026 as fresh.

7. In the meantime, learned AGA may file counter affidavit on behalf of the State.

8. Till the next date of listing, further proceedings of the aforesaid case shall remain stayed against the applicant.
