1. List revised.
2. Heard Sri Jitendra Bahadur Singh, learned counsel for the applicants, Sri Sanjay Shukla, learned counsel for the opposite party no.2 and Sri Ram Prakash Shukla, learned counsel for the State and perused the records.
3. Learned counsel for the applicants argued that the parties have entered into compromise which is dated 16.10.2025, copy of the said compromise is annexed as Annexure no. 5 to the affidavit in support of present 528 BNSS application. It is argued that as such the present proceedings be quashed.
4. Looking to the facts of the case, it is provided that the applicants shall file the said compromise within a period of two weeks from today before the court concerned who shall verify the same within two weeks thereafter and send its report to this Court.
5. Learned counsel for the parties shall be at liberty to file the order passed by the court concerned regarding verification of the compromise, if any, through a supplementary affidavit.
6. List on 23.04.2026.
7. Till the next date of listing, no coercive action shall be taken against the applicants- Alisher, Toni, Smt. Rabbo and Yassen, in S.S.T. No. 2194 of 2022 arising out of Complaint Case No. 425 of 2014 (Jai Bhagwan Vs. Alisher and others) under section 323, 380 I.P.C. and section 3(1) 10 of SC/ST Act, Police Station Vijay Nagar, District Ghaziabad, pending in the court of Special Judge SC/ST Act Ghaziabad.
8. The applicants and the opposite party no.2 shall remit back the

compensation received by them from the State Exchequer in the appropriate head of the Government for which the court concerned shall seek a report from the District Magistrate concerned and the District Social Welfare Officer concerned about the amount as paid to them as compensation and the pass appropriate orders for its depositing back.

9. The order verifying the compromise, if any, shall also mention in it the factum regarding the amount of compensation taken by the applicants and the opposite party no.2 and its remittance.

10. The amount shall be calculated after adding compound interest to it from the date it has been paid till the date of its repayment.
