1. Heard learned counsel for the applicants and learned A.G.A. for the State. None is present for opposite party no.2.
2. Applicants have invoked the inherent jurisdiction of this Court under Section 528 BNSS for quashing the the entire criminal proceeding as well as Charge-sheet No. 59 of 2019, dated 21-02-2019, (State Vs. Smt. Mahadevi and others) in Case No. 7213 of 2019, arising out of Case Crime No. 22 of 2019, under Sections 386, 506 IPC, Police Station- Raya, District- Mathura and the cognizance taken by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-I, Court No.12, Mathura on 18-10-2019 against the applicants.
3. It is submitted that during pendency of the criminal proceeding, both the parties have arrived at compromise and settled their dispute amicably out of the Court. Therefore, instant application may be allowed and criminal proceedings may be quashed.
4. Learned A.G.A. has no objection in referring the matter before the court below for verification of compromise.
5. In this conspectus, as above, both the parties are hereby directed to appear before the court below within three weeks from today to get their compromise verified. The learned court concerned, in turn, shall verify the same in presence of both the parties after recording their statements and submit its verification report on or before the next date fixed.
6. List this matter on **17.10.2025**, before appropriate court, along with compromise verification report submitted by the court concerned, if any.
7. On the next date fixed, opposite party no.2 shall appear through counsel to put her version, if any.
8. Till the next date of listing, interim order dated 17.03.2025 shall

remain continue.

9. This matter shall not be treated as tied up/part heard to this Court.
