1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant, learned counsel for opposite party no. 2 and learned AGA for the State respondents.
2. It is contended by learned counsel for the applicant that the applicant and opposite party no. 2 have entered into compromise and the same is annexed at page nos. 6 to 7 of the supplementary affidavit. It is, thus, submitted that a direction be issued to the office to send the compromise to the learned trial court for its verification.
3. On the other hand, learned counsel for opposite party no. 2 as well as learned AGA have no objection to the aforesaid prayer.
4. In view of the above, the office is directed to send the compromise annexed at page nos. 6 to 7 of the supplementary affidavit, to the concerned Trial Court concerned for its verification.
5. The applicant and opposite party no. 2 are directed to appear before the trial Court on 11.05.2026.
5. Learned trial Court concerned shall verify the compromise and submit a report to this Court within two weeks thereafter.
6. Learned counsel for the applicant may also file supplementary affidavit bringing on record certified copy of the verification proceedings within the aforesaid period of two weeks.

7. Put up this case on 29.05.2026, as fresh.

8. Till the next date of listing, no coercive action shall be taken against the applicant pursuant to Case Crime No. 168 of 2024, under sections 376, 504 of IPC and Section 3(2)(v) and 3(dha) of the S.C./S.T. Act, P.S. Kokhraj, District Kaushambi, pending in the Court of the Special Judge (SC/ST Act), Kaushambi.
