1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant, learned counsel for the opposite party No. 2, learned A.G.A. for the State and perused the record.
2. The present application under Section 528 B.N.S.S. has been preferred to allow this application and quash the recovery warrant dated 14.03.2024 issued by Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Jaunpur in Case No. 1421 of 2023, under Section 128 Cr.P.C., Police Station-Badlapur, District-Jaunpur (Anupam Vs. Pushpendra).
3. Learned counsel for the applicant states that the applicant consents to refer the matter to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, High Court Allahabad, for amicable settlement of the dispute.
4. Accordingly, the matter is referred to Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court. The applicant is directed to deposit a sum of Rs. 90,000/- by way of demand draft/pay order in the name of Allahabad High Court, Mediation and Conciliation Centre (AHCMCC) within a period of four weeks from today. Out of total amount, Rs. 85,000/- shall be payable to the opposite party No. 2 on her appearance before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre which shall be adjusted towards the arrears of maintenance amount due to be paid to opposite party No. 2 and remaining Rs. 5,000/- shall be payable to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre.
5. The matter is referred to the Mediation Centre with the direction that same may be tried to be resolved after giving notices to the opposite party. The Mediation Centre will submit its report in the matter within three months.

6. List this case on 18.05.2026 in the daily cause list before the appropriate Bench alongwith the report of Mediation Centre.

7. It is made clear that in case of default in depositing the amount within the aforesaid period, list this case immediately before this Court.
