1. Sri Rajesh Kumar Sharma, learned counsel for the accused/applicant appears and submits that the FIR of enticement has been lodged by the father of victim. The victim and applicant have married. He submits that the trial is proceeding and there is every chances that the father may also recognise the marriage, as such he submits that the charge sheet, cognizance taking order and the proceeding of the case be quashed.
2. Learned counsel further drawn the attention of this Court towards the birth certificate of child born out of wedlock and the statement of father recorded before the court.
3. Learned AGA for the State seeks time to file counter affidavit.
4. None appeared for opposite party nos. 2 and 3.
5. Issue notice to opposite party no.4 returnable at an early date.
6. List on 16.04.2026.

7. In the meantime, the parties may exchange affidavits.

8. Considering that the accused/applicant and victim have married having a child and there is chances of compromise, further proceeding of Sessions Case No 1221 of 2022 (State Vs. Satyaveer) arising out of Case Crime No. 309 of 2021, under Section 363, 376 IPC and Section 3/4 POCSO Act, P.S. Atrauli, District Aligarh shall remain stayed.
