1. The instant application under Section 482 B.N.S.S. has been filed with the prayer to grant anticipatory bail to the applicant in Case Crime No. 112 of 2024, under Sections 406, 420, 506, 467, 468, 471, 120-B I.P.C., Police Station Ecotech-1, District Gautam Budh Nagar.

2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has been falsely implicated in the present case. The applicant was the marginal witness of the alleged sale-deed executed on 26.06.2012. No amount has been credited in the account of the applicant. The applicant is not a beneficiary of the illicit transaction. The applicant has joined the investigation and is cooperating with the investigation. The investigation is still pending. The applicant has no criminal antecedents. The applicant has apprehension of his arrest in the above mentioned case.

3. Matter requires consideration.

4. Learned A.G.A. has accepted notice on behalf of the State-opposite party no. 1. Sri Dharendra Kumar Dwivedi, Advocate, appears on behalf of the informant.

5. Learned A.G.A. prays for and is granted granted three weeks' time to file counter affidavit. Rejoinder affidavit thereto, if any, may be filed within a week thereafter.

6. Place this case in the week commencing 08.07.2025 in the additional cause list.

7. Till the next date of listing or till the submission of police report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C., whichever is earlier, in the event of arrest the applicant- Veer Singh Bhati in the aforesaid case crime shall be released on interim anticipatory bail on his furnishing a personal bond of Rs. 50,000/- with two sureties each in the like

amount to the satisfaction of the Station House Officer of the police station concerned with the following conditions:-

- (i) The applicant shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
- (ii) The applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) The applicant shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court and if he has passport, the same shall be deposited by him before the S.S.P./S.P. concerned.

8. In default of any of the conditions, the Investigating Officer is at liberty to file appropriate application for cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to the applicant.

9. The Investigating Officer is directed to conclude the investigation of the present case in accordance with law expeditiously preferably within a period of three months from the date of production of a copy of this order independently without being prejudiced by any observation made by this Court while considering and deciding the present anticipatory bail application of the applicant.

10. The applicant is directed to produce a copy of this order before the S.S.P./S.P. concerned within ten days from today, who shall ensure the compliance of present order.
