Heard Mr. Sanjeev Kumar Singh, the learned counsel for petitioner and the learned A.G.A. for State/respondents-1,2,3.

At the very outset, the learned counsel for petitioner submits that due to inadvertence, the first informant- Sub Inspector-Chandrabhan Singh, Police Station- Shahpur, District- Gorakhpur has not been impleaded as party respondent in present writ petition. It is then contended by the learned counsel for petitioner that in a writ petition challenging an F.I.R, the first informant is a necessary and proper party. In the absence of first informant, as a party respondent, the writ petition shall be bad for non joinder of necessary and proper parties. As such, he be permitted to amend the cause title of present writ petition by impleading the first informant as respondent-4.

Prayer made by the learned counsel for petitioner is bonafide. The same is not opposed by the learned A.G.A.

Accordingly it is allowed.

Let necessary amendment in the cause title of this writ petition as well as stay application be carried out by the learned counsel for petitioner during course of the day.

Heard Mr. Shamsheer Singh, the learned counsel for petitioner and the learned A.G.A. for State/respondents- 1,2,3.

On the matter being taken up, the learned A.G.A. submits that following writ petition arising out of same case crime number is already pending before this Court:

1. Criminal Misc. Writ Petition No. 3840 of 2026, (VISHWAJEET VISHWAKARMA @ GUDDU vs STATE OF U.P. AND 2 OTHERS)

In view of above, connect above mentioned criminal misc. writ petition along with present writ petition.

Matter shall re-appear for admission as fresh on 13.3.2026 along with connected writ petition.

When the matter is listed next, the details of both the writ petitions shall be published in the cause list.
