1. Heard Mr. Sanjeev Kumar Singh, the learned counsel for petitioner and the learned A.G.A. representing State/respondents 1, 2 and 3.

2. Perused the record.

3. In connected Criminal Misc. Writ Petition No. 3840 of 2026 (Vishwajeet Vishwakarma @ Guddu Vs. State of U.P. and 2 others), this Court passed the following order:

"1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned A.G.A. for the State and perused the record.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that only on the basis of a solitary case, the impugned first information report under Sections 2(b)(i), 2(b)(xi) and 3(1) of the U.P. Gangsters and Anti-Social Activities (Prevention) Act, 1986, has been slapped against the petitioner, as such, the impugned first information report is bad in law and the same is liable to be quashed.

3. Matter requires consideration.

4. Learned A.G.A. prays for and is granted three weeks' time to file counter affidavit.

5. Rejoinder affidavit, if any, may be filed within one week thereafter.

6. List this case on 23.04.2026.

7. Till then, the petitioner shall not be arrested in pursuance of F.I.R. dated 25.01.2026 arising out of Case Crime No. 27 of 2026, under Section 2(b)(i), 2(b)(xi) and 3(1) of the U.P. Gangsters and Anti-Social Activities (Prevention) Act, 1986, Police Station- Shahpur, District- Gorakhpur. "

4. Notice on behalf of State/respondents 1, 2 and 3 has been accepted by the learned A.G.A.

5. Issue notice to first informant/opposite party-4.

6. Steps for service upon first informant/respondent-4 shall be taken by the learned counsel for petitioner within the time period prescribed under the Rules of Court.

7. All the respondents may file their respective counter affidavits within six weeks.

8. Petitioner will have two weeks thereafter to file his rejoinder affidavits.

9. List this writ petition for admission on 23.04.2026.

10. Till the next date of listing, petitioner shall not be arrested in Case Crime No. 0027 of 2026, under Section 2(b)(i), 2(b)(xi) and 3(1) of the U.P. Gangsters and Anti-Social Activities (Prevention) Act, 1986, Police Station- Shahpur, District- Gorakhpur arising out of F.I.R. dated 25.01.2026.
