Heard Ms. Shabana Nizam, learned counsel for the applicant and Sri Karunakar Singh, learned A.G.A. for the State.

The present application under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita has been filed to quash the entire proceedings of Case No. 1780 of 2023, arising out of Case Crime No. 244 of 2022, under Sections 406, 504, 506 of I.P.C., Police Station- Madiyahun, District- Jaunpur, as well as cognizance/ summoning order dated 14.09.2023 pending in the Court of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-I, Court No. 12, Jaunpur.

Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the first information report dated 05.08.2022 has been lodged on the basis of false and frivolous allegations with ulterior motive and only to harass the present applicant. It is further submitted that charge-sheet has not been submitted under Section 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of I.P.C. in which an F.I.R. was also lodged. As per allegations of the F.I.R., all the allegations are related to purely civil dispute and the first informant instead to file a suit for decree of specific performance of contract/recovery of money has lodged the impugned F.I.R. It is further submitted that the first informant converted a civil dispute into a criminal case.

Prima facie, matter requires consideration.

Notice on behalf of opposite party no. 1 has been accepted by learned

A.G.A.

Issue notice to opposite party no. 2 returnable at an early date.

Learned A.G.A. as well as learned counsel for the opposite party no. 2 may file counter affidavit within two weeks. Rejoinder affidavit may be filed within one week thereafter.

List after eight weeks.

Until further orders of this Court, further proceedings of the aforesaid case, shall remain stayed against the applicant.
