1. Sri Rajneesh Tripathi, Advocate has filed vakalatnama on behalf of respondent No. 4 in the registry on 18.2.2026, however, the same is not on record.
2. Office to trace out the same and place it on record.
3. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners, learned AGA for the State, Sri Rajneesh Tripathi, learned counsel for respondent No. 4 and perused the record.
4. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners has made a statement at the Bar that he does not intend to press this writ petition on behalf of petitioner No. 2 and seeks to withdraw it.
5. In view of the above, the instant writ petition qua the petitioner No. 2 stands dismissed as withdrawn.
6. So far as petitioner No. 1 is concerned, learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that he had scribed the sale-deed in question and has no active role to play in the said incident in question and as such, the impugned first information report qua the petitioner No. 1 is liable to be quashed.
7. In view thereof, matter requires consideration.
8. Learned counsel for the respondent No.4 prays for and is granted three weeks time to file counter affidavit.

9. Learned AGA may also file counter affidavit within the said period. Rejoinder affidavit, if any, may be filed within one week thereafter.

11. Till then, the petitioner No. 1 shall not be arrested in pursuance of the impugned F.I.R. dated 31.1.2026 arising out of Case Crime No. 0053 of 2026, under Sections 318(4), 338, 336(3), 340(2), 351(2) of B.N.S., P.S. Kishani, District- Mainpuri.
