1. Supplementary affidavit filed today is taken on record.
2. Heard learned counsel for the applicants, learned A.G.A. for the State as well as learned counsel for opposite party no. 2 and perused the record.
3. The present application has been filed with the prayer to quash the entire proceeding of Session Case No. 918 of 2024, under Sections 147, 323, 504 I.P.C. against all applicants and under Sections 147, 323, 392 I.P.C. against applicant no. 2, Police Station Sumerpur, District Hamirpur and also set aside the impugned summoning order dated 30.10.2024 passed by the Special Judge (D.A.A.)/Additional District and Session Judge, Hamirpur in Session Case No. 918 of 2024, under Sections 147, 323, 504 I.P.C. against all applicants and under Sections 147, 323, 392 I.P.C. against applicant No. 2, Police Station Sumerpur, District Hamirpur.
4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the applicants that the applicants and opposite party no. 2 have entered into a compromise and they have amicably settled their dispute outside the court and no dispute is pending between them. Learned counsel for the opposite party no. 2 has also agreed on the submission of learned counsel for the appellants that parties have entered into a compromise.
5. Compromise, if any, entered in between the parties can best be ascertained by the trial court, as such, compromise has to be duly verified in presence of the parties before the trial court.
6. Accordingly, for the purpose of verification of the compromise, applicants

as well as opposite party no.2 will appear before the trial court along with original compromise deed in the week commencing **20.04.2026** and the learned trial court shall proceed to verify the compromise-deed. If the aforesaid compromise is verified, a report to that effect shall be prepared by the trial court and the same shall be sent to this Court on or before the next date fixed.

7. List this case on 18.05.2026.

8. Interim order, if any, is extended till the next date of listing.
