1. Heard learned counsel for the applicants, learned AGA for the State and perused the record.
2. The present application under Section 528 BNSS has been filed with a prayer to allow the present application and quash the entire proceeding of Complaint Case No. 1821 of 2022 (Dal Chand v. Mahesh Chand and others) under Sections 420, 465, 506 IPC, Police Station-Kosikalan, District-Mathura as well as summoning order dated 22.12.2025 passed by learned Civil Judge (S.D.) Chhata, District-Mathura.
3. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the applicants that the instant dispute is mainly civil in nature which has been given a criminal cloak. It has also been submitted that a civil suit bearing Original Suit No. 59 of 2021 (Mohan Swaroop v. Mahesh Chandra Bansal) in the Court of learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Chhata Mathura.
4. Matter requires consideration.
5. Issue notice to opposite party No. 2, returnable at an early date.
6. List on 20.04.2026 in the daily cause list.
7. Opposite party No. 2 may file counter-affidavit within four weeks. Rejoinder-affidavit be filed within two weeks thereafter.
8. Until further orders, the entire proceeding of Complaint Case No. 1821 of 2022 (Dal Chand v. Mahesh Chand and others) under Sections 420, 465, 506

IPC, Police Station-Kosikalan, District-Mathura, shall be kept in abeyance.
