1. Written instructions filed today are taken on record.
2. Heard Shri Siddharth Khare, learned counsel for the original petitioner/appellant, Shri Rama Nand Pandey, learned counsel for the Basic Shiksha Adhikari and Shri T.B. Pandey, learned standing counsel for the State-respondents.
3. Today, it has been informed that no better arrangement could have been made to accommodate the original petitioner while giving compliance to the order dated 31.10.2025 passed in Writ-A No.15286 of 2025 (Param Lal and 20 others v. State of U.P. and 5 others). At the same time in paragraph 19 of the affidavit filed in support of the present petition it has been disclosed that a post of Assistant Teacher would fall vacant at a particular institution where the original petitioner seeks accommodation.
4. To the extent the original petitioner is a lady and further to the extent difficulties have been cited as have been disclosed in paragraph 16, 17 & 18 of the said affidavit, it appears desirable that the case of the original petitioner be reconsidered by the Basic Shiksha Adhikari for the purpose of giving effect to the order of the learned Single Judge dated 31.10.2025 passed in **Param Lal (supra)**.
5. To the above extent, we provide that while giving effect to the order of learned Single Judge the B.S.A. may be mindful of the petitioner's concern expressed in her affidavit filed in support of this intra-Court

appeal and her further request to be accommodated at any institution where vacancy is likely to arise in the next 1-2 months.

6. Allowing the B.S.A./respondent no.2 to pass such further orders within next two weeks, put up as fresh on 19.03.2026.
