HON'BLE RAJIV LOCHAN SHUKLA, J.

1. The present anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of the applicant in Case Crime No.92 of 2025 under Section 115(2), 74, 64(1), 351(3) BNS, P.S. Sirsaganj, District Firozabad, with a prayer to enlarge him on anticipatory bail, during the pendency of trial.

2. Learned AGA states that he has not received instructions. He may be granted a short time to obtain instructions.

3. Put up as fresh on 25.02.2026.

4. Till the next date of listing, in the event of arrest of the applicant- **Raman @ Aman @ Bhoora**, involved in the aforesaid case crime, he shall be released on interim anticipatory bail on his furnishing a personal bond and two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Station House Officer of the police station/Court concerned with the following conditions:-

(i) The applicant shall not tamper with evidence and that he would appear before the trial Court on the date fixed unless exempted by the Court concerned;

(ii) The applicant shall not directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her/them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;

(iii) The applicant would co-operate during trial and would not misuse the liberty of bail.

(iv) The applicant shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court concerned.

(v) that the applicant shall not pressurize/intimidate the prosecution witness;

5. In default of any of the conditions, the prosecution shall be at liberty to file appropriate application for cancellation of interim anticipatory bail granted to the applicant.
