1. Heard Sri Shashi Bhushan Mishra, learned counsel for the revisionist and Sri Shashidhar Pandey, learned A.G.A. for the State.

2. Learned counsel for the revisionist submits that he has filed the instant criminal revision with the relief which has been mentioned in the prayer clause. The relief which has been mentioned in the revision is delineated below:-

"It is, therefore, Most Respectfully prayed that this Hon'ble Court may graciously be pleased to allow this revision and set aside the judgment and order dated 9.1.2026 passed by Smt. Kalpna, Principal Judge, Family Court, Kanpur Dehat in Case No. 09/2023, CNR No. UPRN020000342023, Smt. Chandani Singh and another Vs. Umesh Pratap Singh, under section 125 of Criminal Procedure Code, Police Station Gajner, District Kanpur Dehat whereby partly allowed the maintenance case and the revisionist have been directed to make payment of Rs. 5000 /- per month to the O.P.No.2 and Rs. 5000/-per month to O.P.No.3 as maintenance amount from the date of application U/s 125 CrPC i.e. 5.1.2023, otherwise the revisionist shall suffer an irreparable loss and injury.

And/or pass such other and further suitable order or direction which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper under the facts and circumstances of the case."

3. Learned counsel for the revisionist submits that the revisionist/husband is working on contractual basis and getting salary per month in between Rs.17,000 to Rs.23000. The amount of maintenance awarded by the trial court i.e. Rs.5000/- each to wife and child in on the higher side and is not affordable by the revisionist-husband, who only earns meagre amount by his contractual job. He further submits that the revisionist is ready and willing to keep his wife and child along with him with full dignity and honour.

4. Issue notice to O.P. No.2 returnable at an early date. Steps be taken within three days.

5. Opposite parties are granted four weeks' time for filing counter affidavit. Two weeks thereafter will be available to the learned counsel for the revisionist for filing rejoinder affidavit.

6. List this case on 21.04.2026 as fresh.
