HON'BLE RAJIV LOCHAN SHUKLA, J.

1. The Learned A.G.A. submits that he has not received instructions in the present case.
2. Put up **as fresh on 18.03.2026** before the appropriate Court to enable the Learned A.G.A. to obtain instructions in the matter.
3. Till the next date of listing, in the event of the arrest of the **applicant-Mahesh**, he shall be released forthwith in Case Crime No.822 of 2016, under Sections 147, 323, 308, 504, 506 I.P.C., Police Station- Kotwali Padrauna, District- Kushinagar on **interim anticipatory bail** on furnishing a personal bond and two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Station House Officer of the police station/Court concerned with the following conditions:-
 - i. the applicant shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
 - ii. that the applicant shall not, directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
 - iii. that the applicant shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court;

iv. that the applicant shall not pressurize/intimidate the prosecution witness.

4. The matter shall not be treated as tied up/part heard to this Bench.
