1. Heard Sri Amit Daga, learned Senior Counsel assisted by Sri Saumya Srivastava, learned counsel for the applicant, Sri Satyendra Pandey, learned counsel for opposite party no.2 and learned AGA for the State.
2. Learned Senior Counsel appearing on behalf of applicant submits that the applicant is a respectable and qualified medical practitioner, who is having friendly relations with opposite party no.2 since 2018 and on the pretext of the said cordial relations, opposite party no.2 is having favor from the applicant time to time. It has also been brought to the notice of this Court that opposite party no.2 had married to one Ravi Tripathi on 12.04.2021 and it is apparent from the record itself that she/opposite party no.2 was in good relation with the applicant till 2022 and when the opposite party no.2 got the knowledge of the same and he asked her about the money which has been paid by him to support her under the false promise of marriage, the instant FIR has been lodged by the opposite party no.2 against the applicant.
3. Per contra, learned counsel for the opposite party no.2 and learned AGA vehemently opposed the prayer as made through instant application and rebutted the stand taken up by learned counsel for the applicant by way of submitting that cognizance of offence, which has been taken up against the applicant clearly demonstrates from the material available on record in shape of whatsapp messages etc.
4. In view of above, matter needs consideration.
5. All the opposite parties may prefer counter affidavit within one week. One

week thereafter for rejoinder affidavit, if any.

6. Put up this case as fresh on **24.04.2026**.

7. Till the next date of listing, no coercive action shall be taken against the applicant in Criminal Case No.1180 of 2025 (State vs. Anurag Rana), under sections 354D, 509, 504, 506 IPC, arising out of Case Crime No.50 of 2025, P.S. Bhelupur, District- Varanasi.
