1. Heard Sri Ram Prasad Dubey, learned counsel for the petitioner.
2. On the last date of hearing, this Court passed the following order:

- "1. Head learned counsel for the parties.*
- 2. The present writ petition has been filed seeking Mandamus directing the respondent to open the portal for deposit of the fee.*
- 3. The said fact has seriously been opposed by Sri Chandan Sharma, learned counsel for respondent, stating that on various occasions, notices were sent for depositing of the fee but the petitioner failed to do so. On the said premise, a pointed query was made by the learned counsel for the petitioner that as to when the fee from the students was collected, he prays accommodation to bring on record the material of collecting the fee from the students whose fee could not be collected.*
- 4. Learned counsel for respondent shall also indicate how the fee was collected. If by cash, under which provision?*
- 5. List this matter as fresh on 26.02.2026."*

3. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, the petitioner has filed the supplementary affidavit today in Court, which is taken on record.

4. The case of the petitioner is that vide notice dated 05.12.2025, it was informed to the all institutions as well as students that the 'Samarth Portal' will be opened for filling of the examination forms from 05.12.2025 till 09.12.2025 and for completing the examination form, the portal will be open from 08.12.2025 till 09.12.2025.

5. Along with the supplementary affidavit, the petitioner has annexed the receipt dated 10.12.2025, 11.12.2025 and 12.12.2025 regarding the fees collected by the Institution from the students after the last date of filling and completion of the examination form i.e. on 09.12.2025. Thus from the aforesaid receipts produced along with the supplementary affidavit, it is apparent that the Institution concerned has taken the admission of the students after the last date of filling of examination form, which was not permissible for the Institution.

6. Learned counsel for the University-respondent no.2 submits that the said notice dated 05.12.2025 was the last notice for filling and completing the examination form. Previously also various notices were issued with regard to filling of the examination form and completion of the admission and deposit of the examination fee through the portal concerned. After the last date of hearing, the aforesaid admissions have been taken by the petitioner-Institution and now they have claimed that since the only one day was granted for completion of the examination form from 08.12.2025 to 09.12.2025, the portal was not working and they have not been able to fill up their examination form.

7. The aforesaid submission of the petitioner is prima facie against the record submitted along with the supplementary affidavit that those students were not in existence prior to the last date, of filling of the examination form and after the last date, the Institution has taken the admission and played with the future of the said students by assuring the admission.

8. In such view of the matter, learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to refund the fees collected, along with damages at the rate of Rs.10,000/- per student, to the students, whose admission receipts have been annexed along with the supplementary affidavit.

9. A compliance affidavit shall be filed by the petitioner-Institution within a period of four weeks from today along with the acknowledgments from the said students that they have received the refund of their fees and the damages at the rate of Rs.10,000/- per student.

10. If the compliance affidavit is not filed within the period prescribed, this Court will be compelled to issue the contempt proceedings against the petitioner.

11. Put up this on 24.04.2026 as fresh before the appropriate Bench.
