HON'BLE SIDDHARTH NANDAN, J.

1. One Shri Bajrang Lal Srivastava, Advocate has appeared in the aforesaid matter and sought for an adjournment. On being asked whose brief he is holding, he submits that his Senior Shri Arun Kumar Srivastava, who is a colleague of the petitioner's counsel Ram Prasad Dubey, learned counsel for the petitioner had asked him to appear and seek for an adjournment. He has appeared before the court without any file. This practice of the Bar has been deprecated time and again by this court but it seems that there is no effect on the conduct of the counsels while appearing before the court.

2. The court is refraining from imposing a heavy cost but only for today and the same shall be decided after hearing the counsel for the petitioner, in this case.

3. This court vide its previous order dated 26.03.2026 had specifically directed the petitioner to file a compliance affidavit within a period of four weeks, along with acknowledgement from the students that they have received the refund/reimbursement of their fees and damages @ 10,000/- per student. The compliance of the last order by way of filing a compliance affidavit has also not been made. This court had also made it clear that if the compliance affidavit is not filed within the prescribed period, the contempt proceedings shall be issued against the petitioner. For ready reference, Paragraph nos.9 and 10 of the order dated 26.03.2026 is quoted below:

"9. A compliance affidavit shall be filed by the petitioner-Institution within a period of four weeks from today along with the acknowledgments from the said students that they have received the refund of their fees and the damages at the rate of Rs.10,000/- per student.

10. If the compliance affidavit is not filed within the period prescribed, this Court will be compelled to issue the contempt proceedings against the petitioner. "

4. Accordingly, contempt notices are hereby issued to the petitioner. The Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gorakhpur is directed to serve a copy of this order on the petitioner and ensure the presence of the Manager, Shri Sailendra Kumar Yadav, on the next date fixed.

5. The learned Standing Counsel, as well as the Registrar (Compliance) is directed to send a copy of this order to Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gorakhpur.

6. It is also directed that Shri Ram Prasad Dubey, Advocate, Shri Arun Kumar Srivastava, Advocate and Shri Bajrang Lal Srivastava, Advocate, shall also be present on the next date fixed. Shri Bajrang Lal Srivastava, shall communicate this order, to the concerned counsels.

7. Put up this case on 04.05.2026, at 10.00 AM.
