1. Heard Mr. Ranjeet Kumar Mishra, learned Counsel for the petitioner, Mr. C.V.S. Raghuvanshi, learned Additional Chief Standing Counsel for the State-respondents and Mr. Arun Kumar Pandey, learned counsel for the respondent- Land Management Committee.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the impugned orders have been passed in illegal and arbitrary manner without considering the case of the petitioner as setup in objection, appeal and revision.
3. Learned Additional Chief Standing Counsel for the State submitted that there is no illegality in the impugned orders passed by the Consolidation authorities, as such, writ petition should be dismissed.
