1. Heard Mr. Rahul Pandey, learned counsel for the applicants, learned A.G.A. for the State and perused the record.
2. The present application under Section 528 BNSS has been filed with the prayer to quash the Order dated 09.12.2025 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Court No. 12, Ghaziabad, passed in Criminal Revision No. 27 of 2024 (C.N.R. No. UPGZO 10065142023) Suman Kaushik and Ors. Vs. Vidya Devi and ORs. as well as the Summoning Order dated 18.08.2021 passed by Additional Civil Judge (S.D.), Court No. 3/A.C.J.M. Ghaziabad, passed in Complaint Case No. 5499 of 2019 Vidya Devi Vs. Pramod Sharma and Ors. under Sections 323, 504, 506 IPC, Police Station-Link Road, District-Ghaziabad and to quash the entire proceedings of the aforesaid Complaint Case.
3. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the applicants that the alleged grocery shop was allotted to the applicant and the opposite party No. 2 was merely a license holder. It has also been submitted that the instant complaint has been lodged on the basis of false and frivolous allegations. There is no injury report to substantiate the allegations.
4. Matter requires consideration.
5. Issue notice to opposite party No. 2, returnable at an early date.
6. Opposite party No. 2 may file counter affidavit within four weeks. Rejoinder affidavit may be filed within two weeks thereafter.
7. List this case on 18.05.2026 in the daily cause list.

8. Until further orders, the proceedings in Complaint Case No. 5499 of 2019 Vidya Devi Vs. Pramod Sharma and Ors. under Sections 323, 504, 506 IPC, Police Station-Link Road, District-Ghaziabad shall remain in abeyance.
