Order on Criminal Misc. Delay Condonation Application No.1 of 2026

1. Sri Ramesh Chandra, learned counsel for the revisionist submits that he has filed the present criminal revision along with delay condonation application as there is delay of 320 days in filing the criminal revision.
2. Issue notice to the opposite party No.2 for filing counter affidavit within a period of four weeks from today. The revisionist may file rejoinder affidavit within one week, thereafter.
3. List this case on 13.5.2026.
4. It is made clear that the mere pendency of the criminal revision does not preclude the concerned Court from executing its order for maintenance, nor does it preclude the wife from filing an application under Section 127 Cr.P.C. for alteration of the maintenance order in the event of a change in circumstances.
