HON'BLE DINESH PATHAK, J.

1. It has been submitted that the Deputy Director of Consolidation has illegally allowed the revision and remitted the matter before the Settlement Officer of Consolidation on the ground that the Hon'ble High Court, in Writ Petition No. 67404 of 2010, is seized with the subject matter of the proceedings.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the subject matter of the aforementioned writ petition and the subject matter of the pending proceeding, which has been remanded before the Settlement Officer of Consolidation are different. However, there is no specific averment in this regard in the instant writ petition.
3. After due deliberations at length, learned counsel for the petitioners has prayed for and is granted a week's time to file supplementary affidavit.
