1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant and learned A.G.A. for the State.
2. The instant application under Section 528 BNSS has been filed by the applicant with a prayer to quash the entire proceedings of Case No.673 of 2026 arising out of Case Crime No.0371 of 2025, under Sections 308 (5) and 61 (2) BNS, Police Station T.P. Nagar, District Meerut as well as charge-sheet dated 28.08.2025 and summoning order dated 09.12.2025.
3. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant is not named in the FIR and his name has surfaced on the basis of the confessional statement of co-accused. He further submits that the applicant was not present at the place of occurrence and the only role assigned to him is that of hatching a criminal conspiracy. He next submits that the FIR has been lodged on false and concocted facts and as per the evidence collected by the Investigating Officer, no case is made out against the applicant.
4. Matter requires consideration.
5. Issue notice to opposite party No.2 returnable at an early

date.

6. All the opposite parties may file their counter affidavits within two weeks. Rejoinder affidavit may be filed within a week, thereafter.

7. List this case on **15.07.2026**.

8. Till the next date of listing, further proceedings of the aforesaid case shall remain **stayed** against the applicant.
