1. Heard Mr. Suneel Kumar Rai, learned counsel for the petitioners, Mr. A.K.Upadhyay, learned counsel for respondent nos.4 to 7, Mr. C.V.S. Raghuwansi, learned Additional Chief Standing Counsel for the State-respondents and Mr. Bhupendra Kumar Tripathi, learned counsel for gaon sabha.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that against the order passed by Consolidation Officer dated 21.6.1993, highly time barred appeal filed by State as well as one Ramashrya was allowed in illegal and arbitrary manner. He submitted that revision filed by the petitioners has also been dismissed without considering the case as set up in the revision.

3. On the other hand, Mr. A.K.Upadhyay, learned counsel for respondent nos.4 to 7 and Mr. C.V.S. Raghuwansi, learned Additional Chief Standing Counsel for the State-respondents submitted that order dated 21.6.1993 was not passed in proper manner, as such in appeal, order has rightly been set aside. They submitted that order of Consolidation Officer is cryptic order as title objection cannot be allowed by passing four lines order. They submitted that writ petition should be dismissed.

4. Matter requires consideration.

5. Issue notice to respondent nos.8 to 10 returnable at an early date.

6. Steps be taken within ten days.

7. All respondents including State and gaon sabha shall file counter affidavit within six weeks.

8. Rejoinder affidavit can be filed by the petitioners within two weeks thereafter.

9. List this matter on 14.7.2026.
