1. Heard Sri Ashutosh Kumar Mishra, learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Standing Counsel for the respondent nos. 1 to 3.
2. The present petition has been filed seeking a direction to the respondent no. 2 to decide the representation made by the petitioner for extension of area of his firearm licence under Rule 19 of the Arms Rules, 2016.
3. The perusal of the representation shows that it is not in Form-3, as contemplated under Rule 19 of the Arms Rules, 2016, as such, no mandamus can be issued to consider the representation of the petitioner.
4. In view of the aforesaid, this writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh application under Form-3, as contemplated under Rule 19 of the Arms Rules, 2016. If any such application is filed by the petitioner, the Licensing Authority shall consider it, in accordance with law.
