1. Heard Sri Arvind Kumar Sahu, learned counsel for applicants, Sri Amit Kumar, learned counsel for opposite party no. 2 and learned AGA for State.
2. At the very outset, Sri Arvind Kumar Sahu, learned counsel for applicants submitted that both the parties have already been entered into a compromise on dated 20.1.2026 but the same has not been preferred before learned court concerned.
3. Learned counsel for both the parties are hereby requested to advice their clients i.e. applicants and opposite party nos. 2 to file compromise deed dated 20.1.2026 before learned court of Additional District and Sessions Judge, Court no. 9, Moradabad within 15 days from today.
4. In case, the said compromise deed is filed within the stipulated period, learned court of Additional District and Sessions Judge, Court no. 9, Moradabad shall verify the same in presence of both the parties within a period of four weeks thereafter and send its report to this Court through the Registry on or before the next date.
5. List this case in week commencing 11.5.2026 along with said report.
6. Registrar (Compliance) is hereby directed to serve a copy of this order upon learned court of Additional District and Sessions Judge, Court no. 9, Moradabad within **next three working days** and after receiving

verification report, same may be placed in record of this matter, so that the matter may be adjudicated on the basis of verification report.

7. Till the next date of listing, no coercive action shall be initiated against the applicants herein in pursuance to Session Trial no. 284 of 2018 arising out of Case Crime no. 0012 of 2017 (State of U.P. vs. Mahipal and others) under sections 147, 148, 149, 452, 307, 506 IPC at PS- Bilari, District Moradabad which has not been disputed by Sri Amit Kumar, learned counsel for opposite party no. 2.
