1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned A.G.A. for the State and perused the record.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a minor boy and the victim is also a minor girl, aged about 14 years. It is further submitted that the victim out of her own free will and consent, had gone with the petitioner and had already married him and is now living peacefully with him.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further undertakes to ensure the presence of victim before the Investigating Officer positively within three days, who, on her production, shall record her statement under Section 180 of BNSS and thereafter, shall produce her before the competent Magistrate to get her statement recorded under Section 183 of BNSS. In case, her statement is recorded, the competent Magistrate shall forward the copy of her statement to this Court in a sealed cover by the next date fixed.
4. Put up this case as fresh on 31.03.2026.
