1. Heard Sri S.K. Tiwari, learned counsel for the applicant and learned A.G.A. for the State.

2. The instant application under Section 528 BNSS has been filed by the applicant with a prayer to quash the Criminal Case No.08 of 2026 arising out of Case Crime No.058 of 2025, under Section 318 (4) BNS, Police Station Bahsuma, District Meerut as well as charge-sheet dated 05.08.2025 and summoning order dated 16.01.2026.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the FIR has been lodged against the applicant on false and concocted facts. He further submits that the alleged dispute is a family dispute and the applicant is the grandson of the informant. He next submits that the charge-sheet has been filed under Sections 318(4) and 316(2) of the BNS. The summoning order was passed on 16.01.2026, whereby the concerned Court has summoned the applicant for the offence punishable under Section 318(4) of the BNS only. He further submits that there is a possibility of settlement between the parties.

4. Matter requires consideration.

5. Learned A.G.A. has accepted notice on behalf of opposite party No. 1.

6. Issue notice to opposite party No.2 returnable at an early date.
7. All the opposite parties may file their counter affidavits within two weeks. Rejoinder affidavit may be filed within a week, thereafter.
8. List this case on **15.07.2026**.
9. Till the next date of listing, no coercive process shall be adopted against the applicant in the aforesaid case.
