Heard Sri Rohit Dwivedi, holding brief of Sri Rohit Kumar Sharma, learned counsel for the applicant.

The present application has been filed seeking transfer of Case No. 1280 of 2025 (Saurabh Singh vs. Smt. Komal Sagar), under Section 13(1) of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 from the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Meerut to the court of competent jurisdiction at District Gautam Budh Nagar.

It is submitted that the marriage of the applicant with the opposite party was solemnized on 26.02.2023. Thereafter, she was subjected to cruelty and harassment and also dowry demand.

It is contended that on 27.06.2026 applicant upon returning from office found that apartment where she is living with the opposite party was locked and as a consequence thereof, she had to go her maternal home at Gautam Budh Nagar, where she is presently residing.

It is submitted that Case No. 1280 of 2025 Case No. 59 of 2025, under Section 174 B.N.S.S., Complaint Case No. 1309 of 2025 and Case No. 766 of 2025 are pending before courts of competent jurisdiction at Gautam Budh Nagar.

It is further asserted that opposite party is also living at Gautam Budh Nagar and the divorce petition has been filed at Meerut solely with a view

to cause harassment.

It is also asserted that the applicant is receiving continuous threat from the opposite party and would face grave hardship in contesting the proceedings at Meerut.

Matter requires consideration.

Issue notice to opposite party returnable by 20.05.2026.

Steps be taken within a week.

List on the date fixed.

Till the next date of listing, further proceedings of Matrimonial Case No. 642 of 2025 (Manish Yadav vs. Madhu @ Yasha Yadav), under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, shall remain stayed.
