1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners, learned Standing Counsel, and perused the record.

2. It is submitted that despite the direction dated 03.10.2023 issued by this Court in Writ B No.3404 of 2023, the proceedings under Section 9A(2) of the U.P. Consolidation of Holdings Act, 1953 has not been decided till date. For ready reference, order dated 03.10.2023 passed by this Court is quoted herein below:

*"1. Heard learned counsel for petitioner and learned Standing Counsel for State.*

*2. Grievance of petitioner is that his objection/case No.11 of 1999 (Computer Sr. No.2002550531060011) under Section 9-A(2) of U.P. Consolidation of Holdings Act (Ram Suresh and others Vs. Ram Chandra and others) is pending since 1999 before Consolidation Officer, Goplapur, District Gorakhpur and the matter appears to be at the stage of arguments.*

*3. In the aforesaid circumstances, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction that Consolidation Officer shall take endeavour to decide the above referred case after hearing rival parties, expeditiously, preferably within a period of three months from today, if there is no legal impediment."*

3. Learned Standing Counsel has prayed for and is granted three weeks' time to seek instructions from the Consolidation Officer concerned as to why case could not be decided in compliance with the order dated 03.10.2023.

4. List this matter on 13.04.2026 as fresh.
