HON'BLE RAJIV LOCHAN SHUKLA, J.

1. Learned counsel for the applicants; and learned A.G.A. for the State are present.
2. Learned A.G.A. states that he has not received any instructions in the matter and prays for some time to obtain the same.
3. Learned counsel for the applicants states that the applicant are being wrongly summoned for an offence under Section 304 IPC, though no death has occurred in the alleged incident.
4. Learned A.G.A., however, is unable to dispute the aforesaid submission and states that he needs to obtain instructions on this aspect.
5. Time, as sought, is granted.
6. Put up as fresh on 20.03.2026.
7. In the meantime, till 20.03.2026, in the event of the arrest of the applicants- **Pammi @ Jamshed** and **Raju Chaudhary @ Manjoor Ahmad**, involved in the aforesaid case crime, they shall be released on **interim anticipatory bail** on their furnishing a personal bond and two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Station House Officer of the police station/Court concerned, with the following conditions:-
 - i. the applicants shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
 - ii. the applicants shall not, directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to

dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;

iii. the applicant shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court;

iv. the applicant shall not pressurize/intimidate the prosecution witness;

8. In case of breach of any of the above conditions, the Court concerned shall be at liberty to cancel the interim anticipatory bail granted to the applicants.

9. The applicants shall also file a supplementary affidavit annexing the order-sheet of the case and clearly explaining the delay in moving the present anticipatory bail application, particularly when the case was registered in the year 2019.
