During course of hearing learned counsel for the applicant has corrected the memo of this application.

Sri Ashutosh Singh, learned counsel for the applicant, Sri Ishan Mishra, Advocate holding brief of Sri Manu Ghildiyal, learned Standing Counsel for Electricity Department and Sri Karunakar Singh, learned A.G.A. for the State are present.

The present application under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita has been filed to quash the entire proceedings of Criminal Case No. 895 of 2024, arising out of Case Crime No. 300 of 2018, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 411, 201, 120B of IPC and Sections 136 and 137 of Electricity Act, P. S. Panki, District Kanpur Nagar as well as cognizance/summoning order dated 29.07.2024, pending in the court of Special Judge (E.C. Act)/Additional Sessions Judge, Court No. 4, Kanpur Nagar.

Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that impugned FIR dated 19.06.2018 has been lodged on the basis of false and frivolous allegations with ulterior motive and only to harass the present applicant. It is further submitted that the applicant is Junior Engineer of the Electricity Department. It is further submitted that in departmental enquiry the applicant has been found guilty for negligence. There is no pre summoning evidence with regard to the offence as the fine has been deducted from the salary of the applicant.

Prima facie, matter requires consideration.

Notice on behalf of opposite party no. 1 has been accepted by learned A.G.A.

Issue notice to private opposite party no. 2 through C.J.M. concerned, returnable at an early date.

Learned A.G.A. as well as private opposite party no. 2 may file a counter affidavit within three weeks.

Rejoinder affidavit may thereafter be filed within one week.

Connect with Application U/S 528 of BNSS Nos. 16199 of 2019 and 32366 of 2019 and list this case after eight weeks showing the name of Sri Manu Ghildiyal as counsel for the opposite party no. 3.

Until further orders, further proceedings of aforesaid case shall remain stayed against the applicant.
