1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners, learned A.G.A. for the State and perused the record.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are wholly innocent and have been falsely implicated in the present case due to ulterior motive.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has next submitted that prior to the incident, in question, petitioner no.1- Smt. Maya had lodged the first information report against the husband of respondent No.3, which was registered vide Case Crime No.76/2025, under sections 191(2), 174, 333, 115(2), 352, 351(3) of BNS and Section 8 of POCSO Act and in retaliation to the said FIR, the impugned FIR has been registered against the petitioner- Smt. Maya along with her husband with malicious intention and, as such, the impugned F.I.R. is liable to be quashed.
4. Matter requires consideration.
5. Issue notice to respondent no. 3 returnable within three weeks.
6. Steps be taken within a week.
7. Learned A.G.A. may also file counter affidavit within the same period.
8. Rejoinder affidavit, if any, may be filed within one week thereafter.

9. List this case on 20.05.2026.

9. Till then, the petitioners shall not be arrested in pursuance of the impugned F.I.R. dated 11.02.2026 arising out of Case Crime No.0016 of 2026, under Sections 333, 127(2), 64(1), 109, 352, 351(3) B.N.S., P.S. Khanna, District Mahoba.
