1. Vakalatnama filed today by Ms Sindhuja Rathi Bhargawa, learned counsel on behalf of opposite party no. 2 is taken on record.

2. Heard Sri Mayank Yadav, learned counsel for the applicants, Ms Sindhuja Rathi Bhargawa, learned counsel for opposite party no. 2, learned A.G.A for the State and perused the record.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant contended that at page 36, the copy of compromise is annexed as annexure no. 4 to the affidavit in support of present 528 BNSS application. It is argued that as such the present proceedings be quashed. The learned counsel for opposite party no. 2 has also submits his consent on it.

4. Looking to the facts of the case, both the parties are directed to appear before the court concerned and shall file the said compromise duly signed by all the parties for verification within a period of three weeks from today. Thereafter, the court concerned shall verify the same within three weeks and send his report to this Court.

5. List after eight weeks.

6. Till the next date of listing, no coercive action shall be taken against the applicants in Case No. 565 of 2013, under Sections 498A, 323, 506 IPC and Section 3/4 D.P. Act, P.S. Kharkhoda, District Meerut, pending in the court of A.C.J.M, Court No. 5, Meerut.

7. Learned counsels for the parties are also at liberty to file the order of compromise through an affidavit in the present matter.
