1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for respondents

2. The writ petition is filed with the following prayer:

"i. Issue a Writ, Order or Direction in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent nos. 2, 3 and 4 to release the incentive accruing in favour of the petitioners as per the Circular No. 08/2023 dated 20.09.2023 (Annexure No. 1):"

3. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the claim of petitioners for payment of incentive accruing in favour of petitioners as per the Circular No.08/2023 dated 20.09.2023 is pending consideration before the respondents.

4. Learned counsel for respondents submits that in case petitioner s file a fresh representation, the same would be decided in a time bound manner.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, it is hereby provided that petitioners shall file a fresh representation along with a certified copy of this order within one month from today. In the event any such representation is filed, the same would be considered and decided by respondent no.4, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of two months thereafter.

6. With the aforesaid observation/direction, the writ petition stands disposed of.
