1. On depositing the entire awarded amount by the appellant before the Tribunal within six weeks from today, the execution of the award dated 22.12.2025 passed by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal (South), Kanpur Nagar in Motor Accident Claim Petition No. 873 of 2016 shall remain stayed. Out of the entire deposited amount, 50% shall be allowed to be withdrawn by claimants and rest 50% shall be invested in a fixed deposit account in a nationalized bank carrying maximum interest for minimum period of three years.
2. The statutory deposit of Rs.25,000/- made by the appellant before this Court shall be remitted to the claims-Tribunal for adjustment in the

awarded amount.
