HON'BLE RAJIV LOCHAN SHUKLA, J.

1. Learned A.G.A. prays for a short time to verify the contents of the supplementary affidavit filed by learned counsel for the applicant.
2. Put up as fresh before the appropriate court on 21.04.2026.
3. Matter shall not be treated as part heard or tied up to this court.
4. Taking into consideration the fact that the matter relates to Magistrate triable offences and the time is being sought by the learned A.G.A. to verify the contents of supplementary affidavit.
5. In the event of arrest of the applicant- **Brijendra Pratap Singh** involved in the Case Crime No. 0037 of 2026 under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC, Police Station-Gopiganj, District-Bhadohi shall be released on **interim anticipatory bail till 21.04.2026** on his furnishing a personal bond of Rs. 50,000/- with two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Court concerned, with the following conditions :-
 - (i) The applicant shall not tamper with evidence and that he would appear before the trial Court on the date fixed unless exempted by the Court concerned;
 - (ii) The applicant shall not directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her/them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any

police officer;

(iii) The applicant would co-operate during trial and would not misuse the liberty of bail.

(iv) The applicant shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court concerned.

6. In default of any of the conditions, the prosecution shall be at liberty to file appropriate application for cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to the applicant.
