HON'BLE ABDUL SHAHID, J.

1. Heard learned counsel for the revisionist and the learned A.G.A. for the State.
2. Learned counsel for the revisionist has contended that a civil suit regarding the shop in question is pending. The City Magistrate has passed the impugned order contrary to the established provisions of law and has illegally ordered attachment as well as the appointment of a receiver.
3. The matter requires consideration.
4. Let notice be issued to opposite party nos. 2 & 3, who shall file counter affidavit within three weeks.
5. Learned A.G.A. may also file counter affidavit by the said period. Rejoinder affidavit, if any, may be filed within two weeks thereafter.
6. List after five weeks.
7. Meanwhile, further proceeding of Case No. 49 of 2023, State Vs. Manoj Kumar, Computer Case No. D202305310000049 filed under Section 145 Cr.P.C. , Police Station Rajghat, District Gorakhpur shall remain stayed against the revisionist/Rajesh Kumar @ Raju.
8. This order has been granted exparte, hence in view of principle of natural justice, the revisionist is hereby directed to take steps by speed post/registered AD within three days and file supplementary affidavit in compliance thereof within a week, failing which the

appropriate order for vacation of interim order may be passed on the next date.
