1. Rejoinder affidavit filed on behalf of the applicant is taken on record.
2. Ms. Sunita Chauhan, learned counsel for the applicant, Sri Manish Singh, learned counsel for the informant and Sri Shatrughna Yadav, learned AGA for the State are present.
3. At the very outset, learned AGA submits, today applicant filed rejoinder affidavit and along with rejoinder affidavit he filed his identity card of one gas agency situated at Kanpur Dehat and, therefore, ten days' time may be given to him to verify the genuineness of the identity card filed by the applicant.
