1. Heard learned counsel for the applicants and learned A.G.A. for the State.
2. The present application u/s 528 BNSS has been filed with a prayer to quash the entire proceedings of Complaint Case No. 6666 of 2024, under Sections 323, 504, 506 I.P.C., P.S. Ajeetmal, District Auraiya, pending in the Court of Civil Judge Junior Division/ Judicial Magistrate, Auraiya.
3. Learned counsel for the applicants submitted that complaint case has been lodged on the basis of false and frivolous allegations with ulterior motive and only to harass the applicants. It is further submitted that applicant no. 3 is the wife of son of complaint/ opposite party no. 2. It is further submitted that they have falsely been implicated as applicant no. 3 has filed the case against the opposite party no. 2 and her in-laws as Case Crime No. 64 of 2024, u/s 498A, 323, 344, 506 I.P.C. & 3/4 of D.P. Act.
4. Prima facie, matter requires consideration.
5. Notice on behalf of State has been accepted by learned A.G.A.
6. Issue notice to respondent no. 2 through C.J.M. concerned, returnable at an early date.
7. Learned A.G.A. as well as respondent no. 2 may file their counter affidavits within four weeks.

8. Rejoinder affidavit, if any, be filed within two weeks thereafter.
9. List this case after six weeks.
10. Till the next date of listing, no coercive action shall be taken against the applicants in the aforesaid case.
