1. Heard Mr. Harsh Vikram, learned Counsel for the petitioners and Mr. Hari Mohan Srivastava, learned Additional Chief Standing Counsel for the State respondents.

2. Learned Counsel for the petitioners submitted that plot No. 627/1 is largest original holding of the petitioners and the aforementioned plot is situated adjacent to Ganga Expressway, as such, the chak objection was filed claiming allotment over his largest original plot No. 627/1 situated adjacent to Ganga Expressway. He submitted that chak objection and chak appeal have been dismissed in arbitrary manner and proceeding of chak revision has been kept in abeyance till the delivery of possession. He submitted that proceeding of chak revision cannot be kept pending in this manner as petitioner is still in possession of his original plot no. 627/1 which is largest original plot of the petitioners.

3. Mr. Hari Mohan Srivastava, learned Additional Chief

Standing Counsel for the State respondents shall obtain instruction from respondent no.2, Deputy Director of Consolidation Sambhal as to why the proceeding of revision has been kept pending without considering the revision in proper manner.
