1. Heard learned counsel for the revisionist.
2. Under challenge in the present revision is the impugned order dated 16.12.2025 passed by Sub Divisional Magistrate, Sadar, Mirzapur, in Case No. 02976 of 2020 (Suresh Chandra Mishra & others Versus Kamlesh Mishra & others) bearing Computerized Case No. T202016530102976 Under Section 145 Cr.P.C., District- Mirzapur, in which the Learned Court below has proceeded in a ex-parte manner resulting attachment of property under section 146 of Cr.P.C. without hearing of the revisionists.
3. Learned counsel for the revisionist has submitted that no opportunity of hearing has been provided to the revisionist and she has not been impleaded in the said proceeding. She is recorded tenure holder. Learned counsel for the revisionist has submitted that without following the principle of natural justice, the impugned order dated 16.12.2025 has been passed.
4. Learned counsel for the revisionist has further submitted that this court has also passed an order dated 9.2.2026 in Criminal Revision No. 955 of 2026 (Dhirendra Kumar and others Vs. State of UP and others).
5. The matter requires consideration.
6. Issue notice to opposite party nos. 3, 4 and 5 by usual course.
7. Meanwhile, operation of impugned order dated 16.12.2025, passed by Sub Divisional Magistrate, Sadar Mirzapur in Case No. 02976 of 2020 (Suresh Chandra Mishra and others Vs. Kamlesh Mishra and others) bearing Computerized Case No. T202016530102976, under section 145 Cr.P.C, shall remain stayed.
8. This order has been granted exparte, hence in view of principle of natural justice, the revisionist is hereby directed to take steps by Speed Post/Registered AD within three days and file supplementary affidavit in compliance thereof within a week,

failing which the appropriate order for vacation of interim order may be passed on the next date.

9. Connect and list alongwith Criminal Revision No. 955 of 2026 for hearing.
