HON'BLE AVNISH SAXENA, J.

1. Sri Shailesh Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioners appears and submits that the present writ petition has been moved against the State for seeking direction upon respondent no.2 (Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Khadda, District Kushinagar), for early disposal of application under Section 145 Cr.P.C., which is pending since 2025. The prayer in the writ petition is reiterated underneath:-

"(i) Issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of Mandamus, commanding the respondent no.2/ Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Khadda, District Kushinagar, to decide Case No.998 of 2025 (Computerized Case No.T202505440500998), Vipin Bihari Vs. Ramawati Devi and others, instituted under Section 145 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, pertaining to Police Station Khadda, within a stipulated time period as may be fixed by this Hon'ble Court."

2. Hence, seeks interference of this Court.

3. Learned A.G.A. for the State appears and submits that the application shall be disposed of at an early date.

4. There is no point in issuance of notice to opposite party nos.3 to 6, as the innocuous prayer in the writ petition, is for early disposal of the application, moved under Section 145 Cr.P.C.

5. Considering the pendency of application under Section 145 Cr.P.C., the respondent no.2 (Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Khadda, District Kushinagar) is requested to dispose of the the case, detailed above at an early date, if possible, within one month, if there is no legal impediment in deciding the same.

6. The writ petition is accordingly ***disposed of***.
