1. The instant appeal has been filed by the plaintiffs under Section 96 C.P.C. against the impugned judgment and decree dated 12.12.2025 passed by the Civil Judge (Senior Division), Kasganj in Original Suit No.46 of 2017 (Rakesh Chandra and another vs. Gram Sabha and others), whereby the plaintiffs' suit for the relief of permanent injunction has been dismissed on the ground that although plaintiffs are in possession of the disputed property but are not owner of it because the sale deeds were executed in their favour in contravention of the provisions of Section 157-A of U.P.Z.A. & L.R. Act.

2. Learned counsel for the plaintiffs-appellants submitted that the plaintiffs had purchased the disputed property from Darshan Singh, Santokh Singh etc., who were not person of scheduled caste community but still the trial court has held otherwise. Learned counsel submitted that since the above persons did not belong to the scheduled caste community, as such, the provisions of Section 157-A of the Act, 1950 were inapplicable but the trial court has held otherwise.

3. Matter requires consideration.

4. Appeal is admitted.

5. Issue notice to the respondents.

6. Steps be taken by both ways within a week.

- 7. Office is directed to summon the lower court record.
