HON'BLE HARVIR SINGH, J.

1. Ms. Babita Upadhyay, learned Panel lawyer/counsel for the applicant accused submitted that the applicant accused has been awarded a term of ten years arrived under Section 376 IPC and he does not three years arrived under Section 452 of IPC besides a some of Rs. 25/23 thousand under Section 452 of IPC besides of some of Rs. 25 thousand under Section 376 and a some of Rs. 5 thousand under Section 452 has been imposed upon him.

2. Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that the applicant accused has already undergone incarceration for a period of more than seven years. There is no criminal history to his discredit. Under the facts and circumstances of the case, his sentence is liable to be suspension and liable to be enlarged on bail on his furnishing a personal bond and two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Court concerned. It is further directed that the entire amount of fine from the appellant shall be deposited.

3. On acceptance of bail and personal bond, the Trial Court shall transmit photostat copies thereof to this Court for being kept on the record of this appeal.

4. Admit.

5. Summon the Trial court record.

6. Learned counsel for the opposite party may file counter affidavit within

four weeks. Rejoinder affidavit, if any, may be filed within two weeks' thereafter.

7. Let the paper book be prepared.

8. List this matter on **12.08.2026, as fresh.**

9. Smt. Babita Upadhyay, advocate has been appointed as Panel Lawer/Counsel to argue the appeal and a sum of Rs. 10,000/- shall be paid to her as remuneration.
