1. Heard Sri Manish Dev, learned counsel for the petitioner, Sri Satya Priya Mishra, learned counsel for respondent no.3, Sri Sanjay Kumar Ray, learned standing counsel for the state-respondents and Sri Arun Kumar Pandey, learned counsel for respondent-gaon sabha.

2. Counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner is the *chak* holder no.64 and the original holdings of the petitioner are plot nos. 168, 177, etc. He submitted that petitioner was proposed two *chaks* by the Assistant Consolidation Officer, 1st *chak* on plot nos. 163 and 168 and 2nd *chak* on plot no.177/2. He submitted that till the appellate stage, there was no interference with the proposal made by the Assistant Consolidation Officer in respect to petitioner's *chak* nor petitioner was impleaded in any proceeding before the Consolidation Officer or the Settlement Officer of Consolidation. He submitted that six revisions were filed before the Deputy Director of Consolidation and in one revision by way of impleadment application, petitioner was impleaded. He submitted that the original holding of the petitioner has been taken away at the revisional stage and the same was allotted to respondent no.3 who is not the original tenure holder of the plot in question.

3. Matter requires consideration as to whether the petitioner's *chak* can be disturbed at the revisional stage, without considering the hardship of the petitioner in proper manner.

4. Issue notice to respondent nos.4 to 19, returnable at an early date.
5. Steps within 10 days.
6. Respondent No.3 to 19 shall file their counter affidavits within 6 weeks. Petitioner will file rejoinder affidavit within two weeks thereafter.
7. **List on 27.5.2026**, before the appropriate Bench.
8. Until further orders of this Court, the effect and operation of the orders dated 21.7.2025 and 23.12.2025, passed by respondent no.1 in Revision No.202554133800000186/179 (Kunwar Singh vs. Smt. Afroj Jahan and Others), shall remain stayed.
