1. Sri Prakash Tripathi, learned Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of informant and has filed his Vakalatnama on behalf of informant is taken on record.
2. Learned counsel for appellant and Amrit Raj Chaurasiya, learned AGA for State are present.
2. Learned counsel has submitted that both the parties have amicably settled the matter and have entered into compromise. Learned counsel has also submitted that he is in possession of original compromise deed dated 9.10.2025. Act, Police Station Asmoli, District-Sambhal pending in the court of learned Additional Session judge / Special Judge, (S.C./S.T. Act), Sambhal at Chandausi, shall remain stayed.
